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
# Cancer screening

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Our body is made of tiny parts called cells.

When cells go bad this is called cancer.

You can get cancer in different parts of your body.



If cancer is not treated by a doctor in time people can get very sick or die.



Symptoms can be like –

- Losing weight very fast for no reason
- Tired all the time
- Blood in your poo
- A lump that you can feel on your body

You must see your GP to get a check up.



## Cancer screening

To help find cancer sooner NHS offers tests. This is called the **National Cancer Screening Programme**.

The National Screening tests are for:

- Breast
- Cervix
- Bowel (blood in the poo)
