NHS offers tests to help find Cancer sooner.

This is called the **National Cancer Screening Programme**




Breast screening is offered to:

- Women
- Between the age of 50 – 70



The breast screening helps to find cancer in the breast early so that the doctors can treat you in good time

Getting help



At the Breast Screening appointment – doctors or nurses will check your breasts on a machine



Please come for your Cancer Screening Appointment

Your GP will write to you to tell you if you are due to have any of the Cancer Screening appointments



You will be invited every 3 years for the screening



Do not wait for your Cancer Screening appointment if you think you have Cancer symptoms

Take Cancer Seriously and get help as soon as you can!
