

Cervical Cancer Screening



NHS offers tests to help find cancer sooner.

This is called the **National Cancer Screening Programme**



Cervical screening is offered to:

- Women
- Between the age of 25 - 64



The cervix is inside your body above the vagina. You cannot see it.

Cervical Cancer Screening



A doctor or nurse will do a test to check for a virus in the Cervix early so that they can treat you in time.

Your GP will write to you to tell you if you are due to have any of the Cancer Screening appointments



If you are between 25-49 years you will be invited every 3 years for the screening

If you are between 50-64 years you will be invited every 5 years for the screening

Getting help



Do not wait for your Cancer Screening appointment if you think you have Cancer symptoms

Take Cancer Seriously and get help as soon as you can!
